### Focus Group Summary and Review of Data

#### Parent Involvement Expenditures

Most recent survey results revealed the majority of the respondents would like information sent home related to the following:

- Helping with skills at home-85%
- Testing and preparation-83%
- Understanding the state academic standards-81%
- Bullying-80%
- Effective parenting skills for academic success-79%
- Improving reading skills-76%
- Improving math skills-75%

To meet this need, we will need to expend funds on the following at a minimum:

- Resources will be provided at the Camden County Collaborative Conferences (i.e. folders, handouts, make and take items)
- Ink for printer
